2017 EMPIRE GLOBAL ART AWARD TUGGERANONG ARTS CENTRE CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - PLEASE READ ALL CONDITIONS

Tuggeranong Arts Centre and Empire Global invites artists over the age of 18 to enter the Award Competition and Exhibition.

Artists may enter works in any medium, and respond to the theme –
“The greatness of a nation and its moral progress can be judged by the way its animals are treated”. Mahatma Gandhi

The Empire Global Art Award offers a \$4000 prize for an artist aged 18 years or over.

A People’s Choice Award (\$250 voucher from Hang Ups Framing), collected from audience votes over the duration of the exhibition will be awarded at the conclusion of the exhibition.

An exhibition of works selected by the judges will be on display in the Tuggeranong Arts Centre Gallery from the official awards presentation on Thursday 3 August at 6pm until the exhibitions conclusion at 4pm Saturday 2nd September.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - PLEASE READ ALL CONDITIONS

1. Entry is open to artists and craftspeople who are residents of Canberra and region. (this includes Queanbeyan, Braidwood, Goulburn, Yass, and Cooma).
2. There is a limit of one entry per person and a handling and administration fee of \$40 applies. Entry fees are not refundable.
3. All works must be presented ready for hanging and display, two dimensional works must be framed with D-rings attached. Please ensure that the D-rings have an opening of at least 1/2 inch and place them on the reverse of the work, 5cms down from the top either side of the frame with the opening to the top.
4. If you have any special requirements for the installation of your work please contact the curator BEFORE Monday 31 July 2017.
5. Please make a copy of your entry form (page 3 of this document). Entry forms must accompany artwork, and should be taped to the reverse side.
6. Artwork must be original, completed within the past two years and not previously exhibited in the ACT. It is the artist's responsibility to ensure there is no infringement of copyright laws—any enquiries concerning copyright from judges will be referred to the artist concerned.
7. Artworks should respond to the theme “The greatness of a nation and its moral progress can be judged by the way its animals are treated”. To be eligible for votes in the People's Choice Award artworks MUST respond to this theme.
8. Staff, partners and immediate families of Tuggeranong Arts Centre, Tuggeranong Community Arts Association and Empire Global are not eligible to enter.
9. Freight and associated costs to and from the Tuggeranong Arts Centre are the artist's responsibility.
10. The exhibition will be hung at the curators' discretion and no correspondence/discussion entered into. The judges will select artworks they feel suitable for exhibition. Judges and TAC reserve the right to reject artworks they feel do not meet exhibition standards or pose display or OHS problems
11. Do not submit work that is still drying, this particularly applies to oil paintings, which will be damp tested when presented for entry.
12. All artworks must be for sale. Pricing of artworks must include the 30% commission due to TCA.
13. There are no size restrictions and large works are encouraged, however please be aware that excessive size or weight can make the work difficult to display, and therefore should be discussed with the curator in advance.
14. The artist agrees to grant Tuggeranong Arts Centre a non-exclusive, limited license to use images of their work as provided, for the promotion of the exhibition and for the broader gallery program and organisation. Where significant cropping or alteration is considered, permission will be sought from the artist.
15. Artworks must be delivered to the Arts Centre Gallery on Monday 31st July 2017 between 10am and 5pm. Please note that no artwork will be accepted before or after that time, unless by prior arrangement with the curator. Should a work not be selected for the exhibition, the artist will be contacted on Tuesday 1st August to collect their work.
16. Sold artworks must remain on exhibition until Saturday 2nd September 2017.
17. Unsold works must be collected by midday on Monday 4 September 2017. Artwork not collected will be disposed of at the discretion of TCA. There is no storage capacity at the Centre.
