Exhibition Statement

Home ownership is an unobtainable dream for many Australians. Most are facing uncertainty amidst the current cost of living crisis and many families are being forced to make huge sacrifices in order to keep a roof over their heads. *Open Home* reflects on the safety and fragility of the home through a series of uniquely human rooms at 1:12 scale.

These imagined, miniature living spaces invite you, the audience, to participate in an intimate open home experience. The careful placement of inanimate objects, enable you to draw assumptions about, give identities to, and create in your mind, the inhabitants of these strangely familiar spaces. The residents indirectly show us the importance and value of their homes, and the aspects which make their home theirs, through the collection and arrangement of material possessions

Open Home further explores how a home operates as both a physical living space and a memory space. This memory space activated in the architecture and the arrangement of the inhabitants' personal effects within these miniature spaces. Each room encouraging you to further investigate these private spaces and reflect on how the everyday tells each of our unique stories.

About the Artist

Claridge's works explore the absurdity of the everyday through the lens of personal narrative. She is constantly experimenting with new media, however continually finds herself reaching back to the same thematic elements of nostalgia, connection to place, temporal versus fixed spaces and memory, exploring how these are emphasised through material choices. Through this evolution, she is delighted to share her works which confront the fragility and impermanence of place, and how this connection to place is reflected in everyday materials and objects.

Claridge is a recent graduate of the Australian National University (ANU) and holds a Bachelor of Science and a Bachelor of Visual Arts. Her multi-media works are held in both private and public collections including the National Film and Sound Archive and the ANU's College of Health and Medicine. Claridge currently holds a 2023 residency at Studio Studio.
